

SHARE is a novel initiative of SKVM School in partnership with KSSEM College of Engineering and Management. About 50 student beneficiaries of class 9 and class 10 of SKVM School have been divided into 6 groups. Each group typically has 8 students needing personal attention and assessment if feasible.

Dr Rangarajan, our school management committee member, visited KSSEM and briefed them on the Programme last week.

A pre-test is electronically conducted every Tuesday/ Wednesday with the support of SKCT volunteers. The test results are shared with KSSEM student-faculty beforehand. This paves the way to understand challenges of SKVM students and thereby address these in a targeted way through the support of KSSEM student- faculty on Saturday.

We are hopeful that this will be excellent Programme enabling senior College students to help junior school students to achieve success.

From the KSSEM, College students are divided into six groups (we have called them the Student-Faculty). Each Faculty group has 2 or may be 3 members. On Saturdays (20/08/2022), these student-faculties from KSSEM came and taught the conceptual learning and doubt clearance for SKVM students.

This ensured personal attention and close to 1-1 tutoring on doubts.
