



RULES AND REGULATIONS

Students are instructed to follow the rules and regulations of the college for the smooth conduction of academic activities.

REGISTRATION:

- Classes for the III, V and VII (ODD Semesters) will start from -----.
- All students are advised to attend the classes from day one failing which
 - They will not be able to meet the attendance requirement..
 - They will have to bring their parents to get permission to attend the classes.
- First day of every semester will be called as "Registration Day". On registration day every student will have to
 - Submit Registration form at the respective departments, duly signed by Student & Parents.
 - Submit latest stamp size photograph.
 - Collect stationeries required for the semester from the department by producing the fee paid receipt.
 - Note calendar of events, lesson plan and Time Table.

ATTENDANCE:

Students must attend their classes regularly as per the VTU rules, and must have 85% attendance or above in each subject for being eligible to appear in University Examinations. A student having shortage of attendance even in one subject will be detained without any consideration. No appeal in this regard will be entertained.

PLACEMENT & TRAINING:

Attendance for the placement training is compulsory failing which suitable action will be initiated.

DISCIPLINE

All the students are required to observe discipline to maintain the decorum in the college. In case of violation of any said rules by any student, disciplinary action will be initiated as per the college / university rules. The Principal of the college, Heads of the department and the teachers, shall have the authority to exercise all such disciplinary action over students in the college, as may be necessary for the proper functioning of the institution. Celebrating Holi, Birthday, Diwali inside the college / hostel premises is strictly prohibited.

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING:

Ragging is not only punishable under Section 116 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), but also under various provisions contain in sections of IPC which results in imposition of extreme punishment on furtherance of the specific directions enshrined in standing order No.940 of Director General and Inspector of Police. As per the AICTE notification "Ragging is prohibited as per the decision of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No.(C) 656/1998"

IDENTITY CARD

All students should wear ID card compulsory inside the campus, failing which they will not be allowed inside the campus. If the identity card is lost, a duplicate must be obtained.

FEES

All students have to pay fee and dues if any, on or before the date indicated in the fee structure, failing which they will not be admitted to the classes.

MOBILE PHONES:

TESTS

Students should write all the Internal assessment tests compulsorily. Students found committing malpractice in theory and laboratory internal test will lead to Mal-practice Case (MPC) as per VTU rules and regulations.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. Identity card, library card and college bus pass should be carried to college everyday
2. Students are advised to dress neatly with proper foot wear. GIRLS – Salwar Kameez, Chudidar with Dupatta, BOYS – Formals. Casual Wear including Jeans, Collarless T-Shirts, Low waist pants, multipockets pants, cargo pants, T-Shirts with slogans etc. are **strictly prohibited** and failing to follow the dress code, students will not be allowed to enter the college premises.
